- Q. Is the Rx Advantage program an insurance plan?
- A. No, the Rx Advantage prescription drug program is **NOT** insurance and cannot be used in conjunction with any insurance plan.

- A. Your Rx Advantage card cannot be used in conjunction with an insurance plan. The RX drug program is NOT insurance. However, you are able to use your card to purchase prescriptions that are not covered by your insurance plan.
