AUSTIN, Texas (July 14, 2016) – The [United Heritage Charity Foundation](http://www.uhcu.org)'s sixth-annual Auto Raffle raised a record \$70,424 this year. Funds raised through raffle ticket sales make possible the Charity Foundation's charitable objective throughout the year.

The \$1 winning ticket was purchased at United Heritage Credit Union's Manchaca branch and drawn at an event held at Howdy Honda.

Proceeds from the Auto Raffle benefit local charities supported by the United Heritage Charity Foundation. Since the first drawing in 2011, the Auto Raffle has raised a total of \$336,905 for the Foundation.
