What You Need to Know about Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An overdraft occurs when you do not have enough in your available balance* in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We offer overdraft protection plans, including a link to the share/savings account under your membership account. You may also authorize overdraft protection links to other share/savings or checking accounts on which you are authorized to complete transactions and these linked accounts may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us.
- 2. We also have standard overdraft practices that come with your account.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We <u>do</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transaction unless you ask us to:

• Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction.

If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

➤ What fees will I be charged if United Heritage Credit Union pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We will charge you a fee of up to \$28 each time we pay or authorize an overdraft.
- There is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account.
