2020 Board Nominations Announced

United Heritage has two Board of Director seats to be filled by election at the 2020 Annual Membership meeting. The Nominating Committee has nominated the following candidates for these positions:

Robert W. Spurck, Jr.

Robert W. Spurck, Jr. joined the Board of Directors as an associate member in 2015 and was elected as a member of the Board in 2017. He has been a UHCU member since 2012. Mr. Spurck is Principal at RB Healthcare Ventures, LLC. He received his Bachelor of Science in Biology from Tulane University in New Orleans, Louisiana, and his Master of Science in Health Care Administration from Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas. At Tulane, he was a three-year varsity letterman in basketball.

Mr. Spurck is the former Chief Executive Officer of both Austin Diagnostic Clinic and Brackenridge Hospital. Mr. Spurck is the former Chairman of The ARC; is the Chairman of the Concordia University Nursing Advisory Board; is a Board Member of the Williamson County Institute of Excellence; serves on the Board of the Renfert Foundation; and holds a membership with the American College of Health Care Executives.

H. Ralph Wilburn, PHD, CCD

H. Ralph Wilburn is Vice Chairman of the United Heritage Board of Directors. Dr. Wilburn has been a member of the United Heritage Board of Directors since 1999 and has been a UHCU member since 1984. Prior to his appointment to the Board of Directors, Dr. Wilburn served on the Supervisory Committee for four years, two of those as Chairman. He graduated from The Credit Union Directors Leadership Institute, where he earned the prestigious designation of Certified Credit Union Director (CCD).

Dr. Wilburn retired from the United States Air Force in 1984 as a Chief Master Sergeant with 30 years of service. Throughout his USAF career he held numerous financial and management positions, and holds a master's degree in Human Resources Management from Pepperdine University along with a doctorate from the University of Texas at Austin. Dr. Wilburn is an assistant professor in the Munday School of Business at St. Edward's University.

Members of United Heritage may vote on these candidates or submit other nominations by petition. A valid petition must contain a certificate from a nominee stating their agreement to serve if elected, a statement of qualification, biographical sketch and the signatures of at least one-half percent of the membership. As United Heritage By-Laws state, write-ins or floor nominations are not permitted at the Annual Meeting.
